Harder Functions



Given $f(x) = x^2 - 3$ and $g(x) = 2x + 4$ find $(g \circ f)(x)$.

Bronze ★

The functions f and g are such that $f(x) = 3x + 6$ and $g(x) = 7 - 2x$
Show that $fg(2) = 15$

Bronze ★

For all values of x , $f(x) = x^2 + 3$
 $g(x) = x - 2$.

a) Show that $fg(x) = x^2 - 4x + 7$

b) Solve $fg(x) = gf(x)$

Silver ★

The functions f and g are such that $f(x) = 4x + 2$ and $g(x) = 2 - 4x$

Prove that $f^{-1}(x) + g^{-1}(x) = 0$

Gold ★



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Answers



Given $f(x) = x^2 - 3$ and $g(x) = 2x + 4$ find $(g \circ f)(x)$.

$$\begin{aligned}(g \circ f)(x) &= g(f(x)) \\&= g(x^2 - 3) \\&= 2(x^2 - 3) + 4 \\&= 2x^2 - 6 + 4 \\&= 2x^2 - 2\end{aligned}$$

Bronze ★

The functions f and g are such that $f(x) = 3x + 6$ and $g(x) = 7 - 2x$
Show that $fg(2) = 15$

$$\begin{aligned}fg(x) &= 3(7 - 2x) + 6 \\fg(x) &= 21 - 6x + 6 \\fg(x) &= 27 - 6x \\fg(2) &= 27 - 6 \times 2 \\fg(2) &= 15\end{aligned}$$

Bronze ★

For all values of x , $f(x) = x^2 + 3$
 $g(x) = x - 2$.

a) Show that $fg(x) = x^2 - 4x + 7$

$$\begin{aligned}fg(x) &= (x - 2)^2 + 3 \\&= x^2 - 4x + 4 + 3 \\&= x^2 - 4x + 7\end{aligned}$$

b) Solve $fg(x) = gf(x)$

$$\begin{aligned}gf(x) &= x^2 + 3 - 2 \\&= x^2 + 1 \\∴ x^2 - 4x + 7 &= x^2 + 1\end{aligned}$$

$$-4x = 1 - 7$$

$$-4x = -6$$

$$4x = 6$$

$$x = \frac{6}{4} = 1\frac{1}{2}$$

Silver ★

The functions f and g are such that $f(x) = 4x + 2$ and $g(x) = 2 - 4x$

Prove that $f^{-1}(x) + g^{-1}(x) = 0$

$$f^{-1}(x) = \frac{x - 2}{4}$$

$$g^{-1}(x) = \frac{x - 2}{-4} = \frac{2 - x}{4}$$

$$\begin{aligned}\frac{x - 2}{4} + \frac{2 - x}{4} &= 0 \\ \frac{x - x - 2 + 2}{4} &= 0\end{aligned}$$

Gold ★
