


Blooms Races



Instructions

- 1) Select a counter and place it at the start and decide who is going first.
- 2) Each player starts with a time of 3 minutes.
- 3) When you answer a question correctly you get a speed boost of - 10 seconds , when you answer a question incorrectly you get a time lapse + 15 seconds. These times get deducted or added accordingly onto your 3 minute start time.
- 4) Use the wheel to find how many squares to move forward or back depending on if your answer was right or wrong.
- 5) When answering questions based on the blooms taxonomy, use the key word cards provided and blooms mat.

(Pros and Cons).</p> <p>Compare – make a comparison between for example methods, structure or characters.</p>	<p>Generate – Design your own questions, with answers, on the topic and ask your group to answer.</p> <p>Construct – a definition, examples or a story about the topic.</p> <div data-bbox="970 1110 1126 1276" data-label="Image"> </div>	<p>Judge – give your opinion on the topic.</p> <p>Assess – look at the positives and negatives and summarise the topic.</p> <p>Critique – Be critical of the topic looking at all sides of the argument.</p> <p>Justify – Give a reason behind your opinion on the topic.</p>
